Signs of Spring 20 Teaching Ideas

- 1. Take the students outside on a walk, ask them to observe the signs of spring (dampness, birds chirping, sprouting, bugs, buds, temperature...) ask them to notice what they see, feel, and smell.
- 2. Have students complete the sentence starter Spring Is.....
- 3. Plant seeds in mini paper or Styrofoam cups and monitor their growth.
- 4. Compare and contrast the clothing worn in spring versus the other seasons.
- 5. Brainstorm all of the holidays that occur in spring.
- 6. Decide what the best and worst things about spring are.
- 7. Write a letter to Mother Nature asking her 5-10 questions about spring.
- 8. Create a poster about 'April Showers Bring May Flowers'.
- 9. Grow a potato or a sweet potato in the classroom.
- 10. Celebrate Earth Day
- 11. Listen to the sounds of spring, use a nature walk to observe the different sounds heard outside.
- 12. Discuss weather patterns in spring and compare them to weather patterns in the other seasons.
- 13. Make a list of everything that reminds you of spring and state why.
- 14. Look through newspapers and magazines, cut out everything that reminds you of spring and make a collage of 'all things spring'.
- 15. 15. Write a letter to a Martian explaining what spring is and what spring brings.
- 16. Use pictures from magazines and newspapers to create a poster called "I See Spring".
