

Keywords in Writing Study Sheet

How well do you know keywords for writing? Here is a list of some of the common keywords for writing with a brief definition.

| 1. | Classify | Identify features in order to put things or ideas into groups. |
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| 2. | Identify | Name, list or indicate who or what. |
| 3. | Outline | Provide an overview of the main ideas or a plan of the subject or topic. |
| 4. | Describe | Provide details about the subject or topic. |
| 5. | Review | Provide an overview of main points of the topic. |
| 6. | Summarize | Provide a concise overview of the main points. |
| 7. | Assess | Make your own judgements about the topic with careful consideration and discuss how you arrive at your conclusion. |
| 8. | Define | Describe what something is. Provide a definition. |
| 9. | Explain | Provide clarification by describing specific details, facts or ideas that will enhance understanding. |
| 10. | Analyze | Write about each part of the subject by separating it into parts. |
| 11. | List | A set of items or names. |
| 12. | Illustrate | Use examples, pictures or diagrams. |
| 13. | Argue | Provide your opinion either for or against using examples, proof, evidence, facts or details. |
| 14. | Sequence | Provide an order of the events as they happen. |
| 15. | Evaluate | Carefully consider all aspects to formulate your ideas to make careful judgements about the topic. |
| 16. | Debate | Write about the different opinions about a topic or a subject. |
| 17. | Compare | Consider how things are similar and different. |
| 18. | Discuss | Provide details about a subject and consider different ideas and opinions. |
| 19. | Provide Evidence | Use proof to back up your writing with facts or supporting details. |
| 20. | Contrast | Consider how things are different. |
