



Finding Multiples Multiples of 2 are: 4, 6, 8, 10, 12.....

Mutiples: Remember that multiple sounds like multiply. 12, 18, and 24 are all multiples of 6 because each one adds 1, 2 or 3 sixes to the number 6, or uses 6 x 2 or 6 x 3 or 6 x 4 etc. If you count up by the given number, each one will be a multiple: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20....


