

## Finding Multiples <br> Multiples of 2 are: 4, 6, 8, 10, 12.....

Mutiples: Remember that multiple sounds like multiply. 12, 18, and 24 are all multiples of 6 because each one adds 1 , 2 or 3 sixes to the number 6 , or uses $6 \times 2$ or $6 \times 3$ or $6 \times 4$ etc. If you count up by the given number, each one will be a multiple: $4,8,12,16,20 \ldots$.
