4. Use Capitals and Punctuation

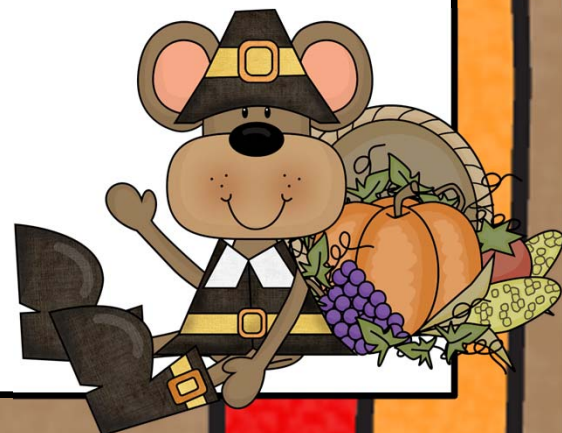
5. Check Your Spelling

8. Be Proud of Your Work: Remember that every piece of writing is an achievement, so be proud of what you create!

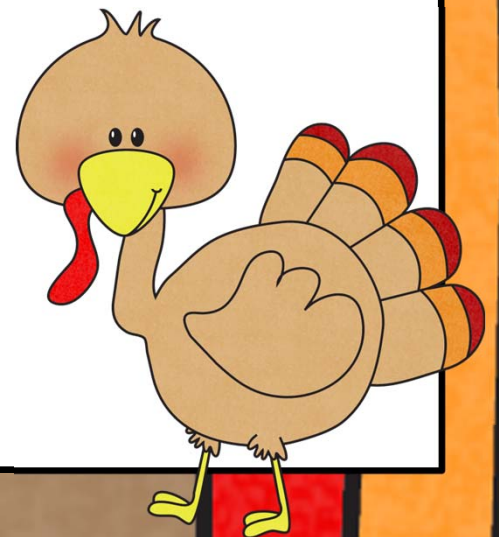
