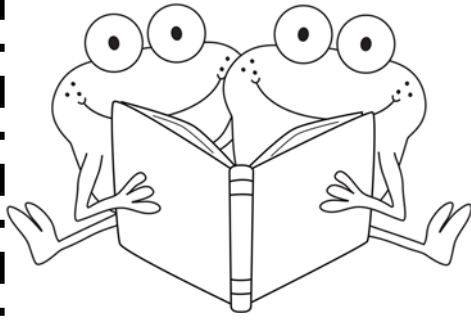

### **BEFORE**

Set a goal

Preview the text

Predict what the text will say

### **DURING**

Reading sequentially, skimming some parts,  
focusing on others

Rereading some sections

Make notes

Tune in to main ideas and ideas related to goal

Check and adapt predictions

Monitor and repair comprehension

Connect to world knowledge to make inferences

Paraphrase and summarize passages

Respond to and evaluate text

### **AFTER READING**

Reread selectively

Summarize

Reflect

Thinks about how information might be used in the future
