

- Earth's atmosphere is made up of mostly nitrogen (78%) and oxygen (21%) and other gasses in smaller amounts.
- Oxygen is needed by animals to breathe and carbon dioxide is used by plants in photosynthesis
- Earth's atmosphere has six layers: the troposphere, the stratosphere, the mesosphere, the thermosphere, the ionosphere, and the exosphere
