

SUGGESTIONS FOR CLIPART USE

- 1) The following pages of clipart come from Pixabay and are free to use.
- 2) Have students classify the clipart in a variety of ways:
Habitat | *Land/Air/Water* | *Food chain* |
- 3) Have students create a collage of their favorite habitat and label them.
- 4) Use the clipart in the mini books if students are uncomfortable with drawing.
- 5) Create mini books that explain what the animal is, what it eats, what eats it and where it lives. For an extension, include animal adaptations.
- 6) Create riddles for the clipart—I'm an animal I live in the desert, I slither...
- 7) Have students draw the type shelters for a set number of animals.
- 8) Use the animals for the flip book instead of drawing—include labels.
- 9) Write 3 facts in your journal or interactive page on each.
- 10) Complete a KWL, what I know about this, what I want to know and what I learned.
- 11) Make a label for each—which habitat and why you think that.
