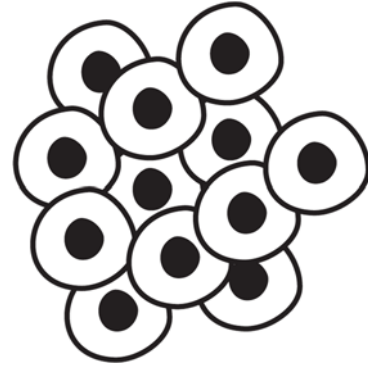
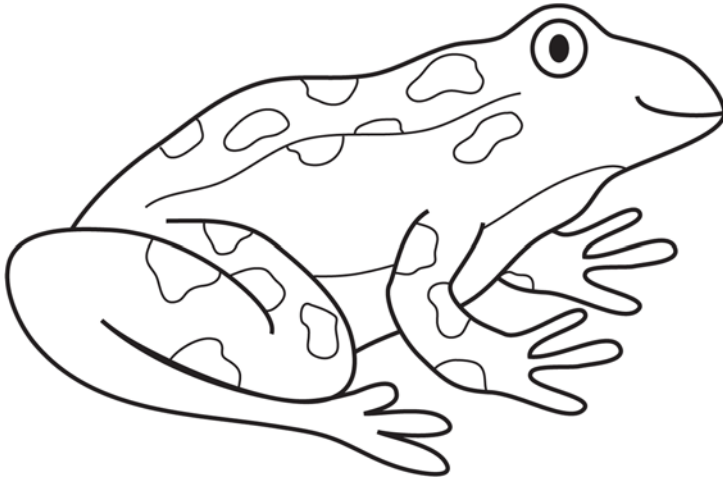
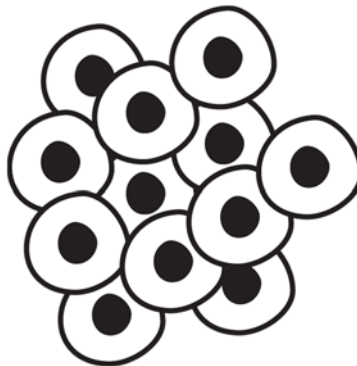
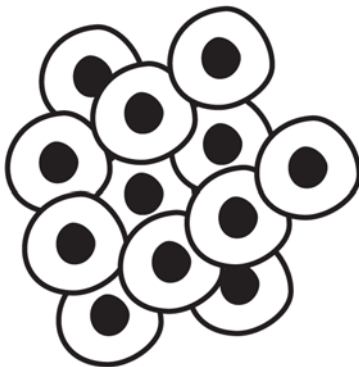


# Life Cycle of a Frog



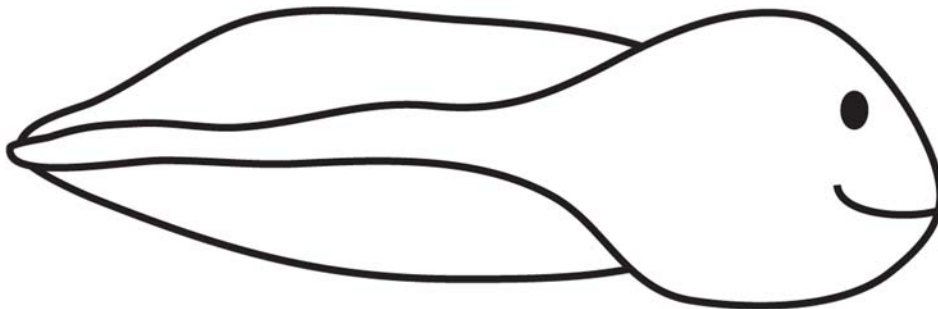

It takes about 6 to 21 days for the eggs to hatch.



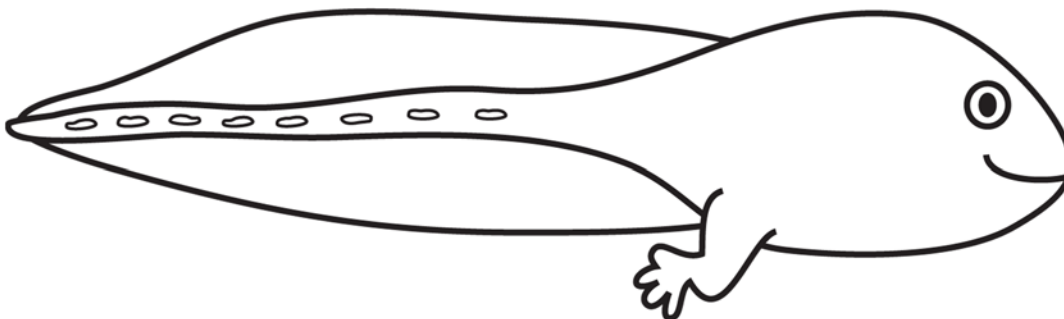

The egg hatches, into a tadpole and begins swimming in about 7 days.



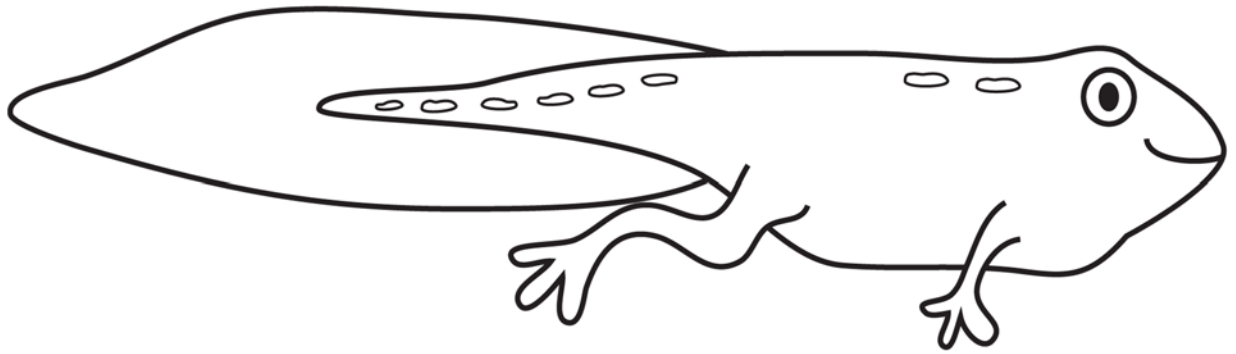

In about 9 weeks, the tadpole sprouts arms.



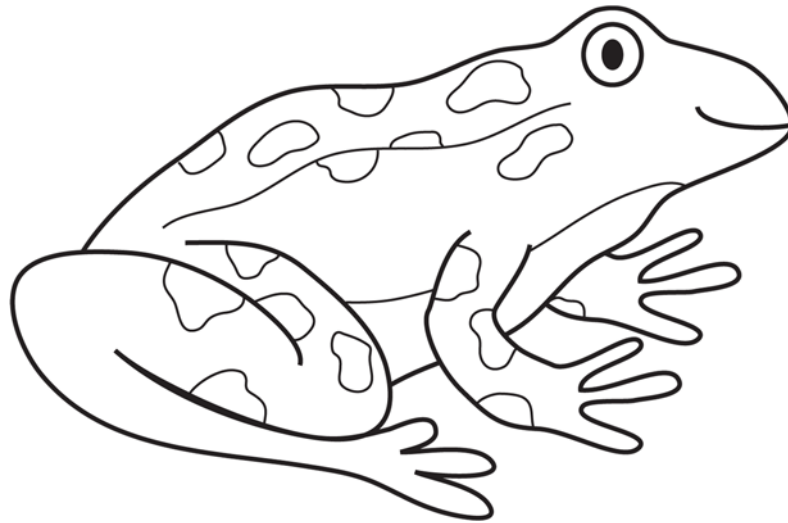

By about 12 weeks, the tadpole looks like a frog with a tail.



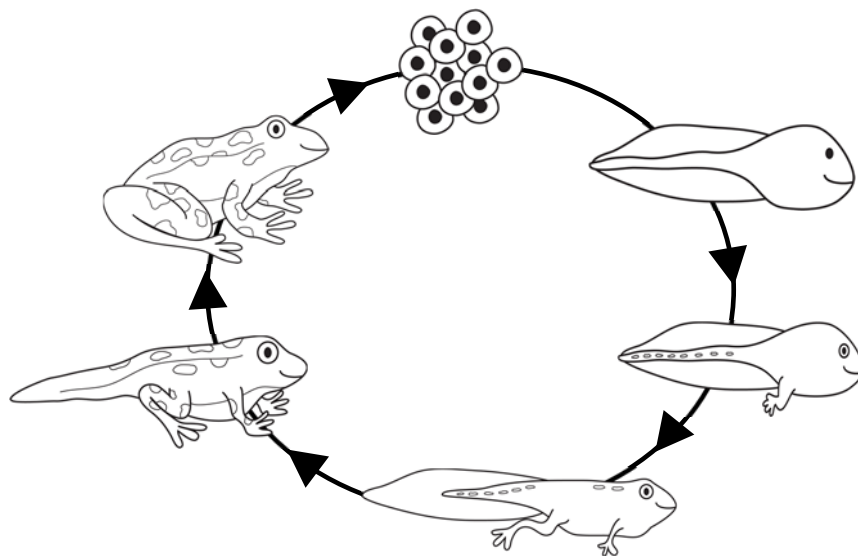
