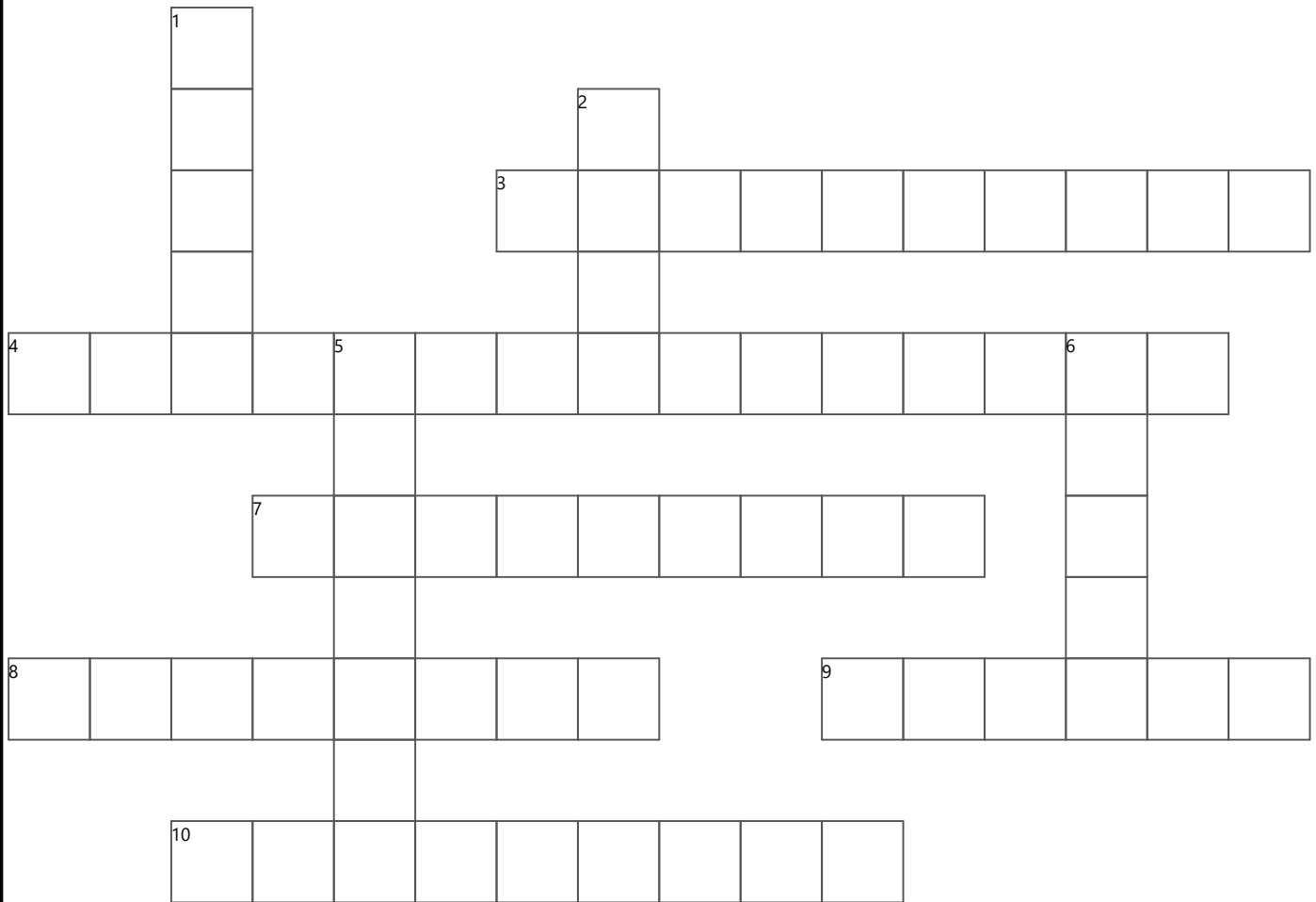


Geosphere Crossword



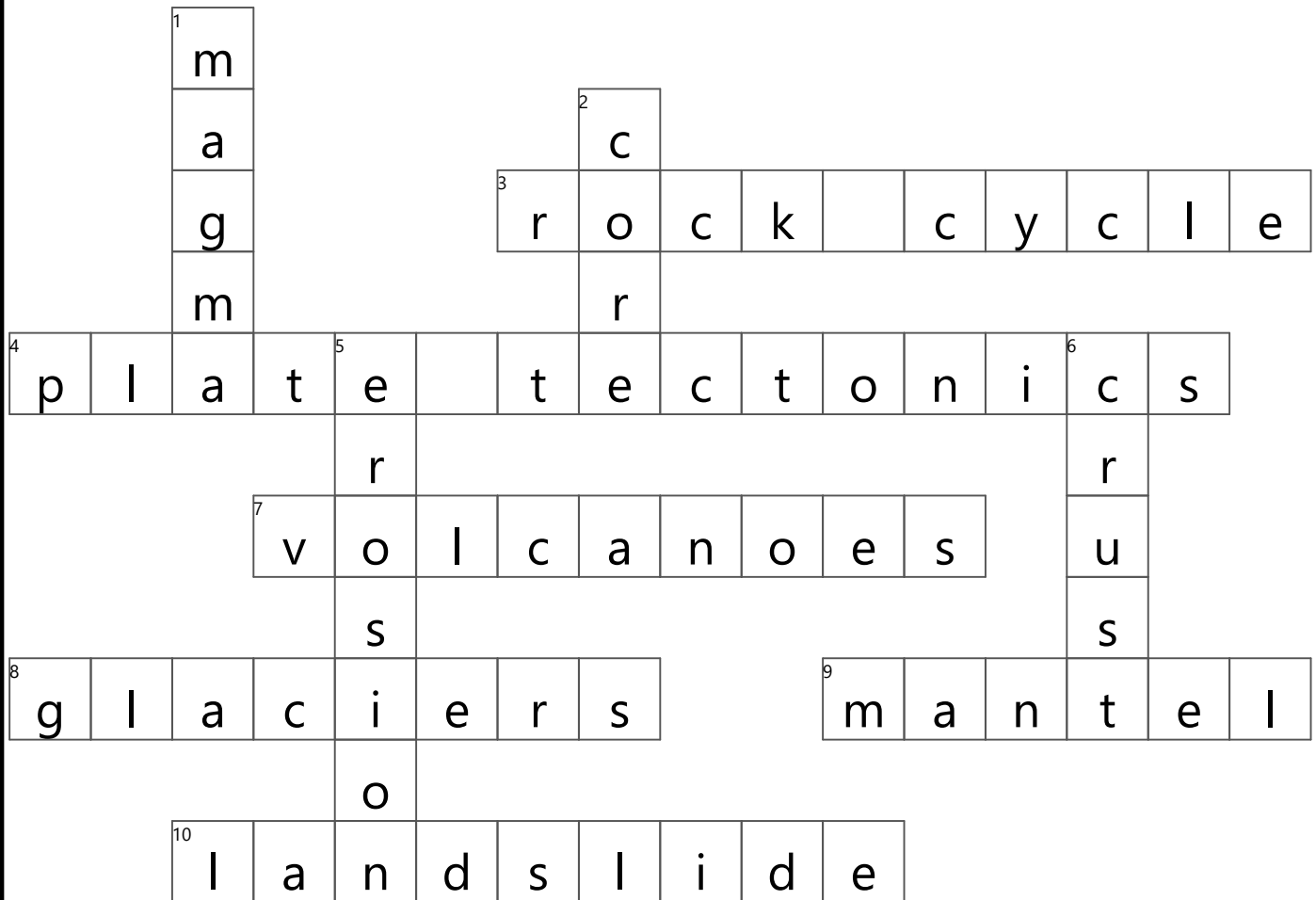
ACROSS
