Write All About Your Journey to one of the Habitats

- 1. Your first paragraph should be a compelling one and convince your readers why they would want to know all about your trip.
- 2. Identify where the habitat is that you are visiting.
- 3. Explain how you will get there and how long you will stay.
- 4. Indicate everything you will bring including the type of clothing.



- 5. Once there, identify what you see and provide vivid details.
- 6. Write about all the things you see and describe how the animals and how the plants adapt to their environment. Add very specific descriptions to make your readers feel that they were there.
- 7. Include the favorite parts of your journey and the least favorite parts of your journey.
- 8. When concluding, leave the reader with a few thoughts to help them to decide whether or not they would like to take a journey similar to yours.

Before writing:

- identify the animals, what they look like and how they survive
- think about the landscape and the non living things that you will include in your journey
- include the flowering and non flowering plants you will see and be prepared to describe them in detail
- describe where the water is found and how plants and animals get their food

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
