12. STERNUM Flat plate of bones also referred to as the chest bone or breastbone.
13. BONE MARROW Where blood is made within the bones.
14. CAPILLARY The body's smallest type of blood vessel.
15. ESOPHAGUS Tube that transports food from the mouth to the stomach.
16. KIDNEY Bean shaped organ that makes urine.
