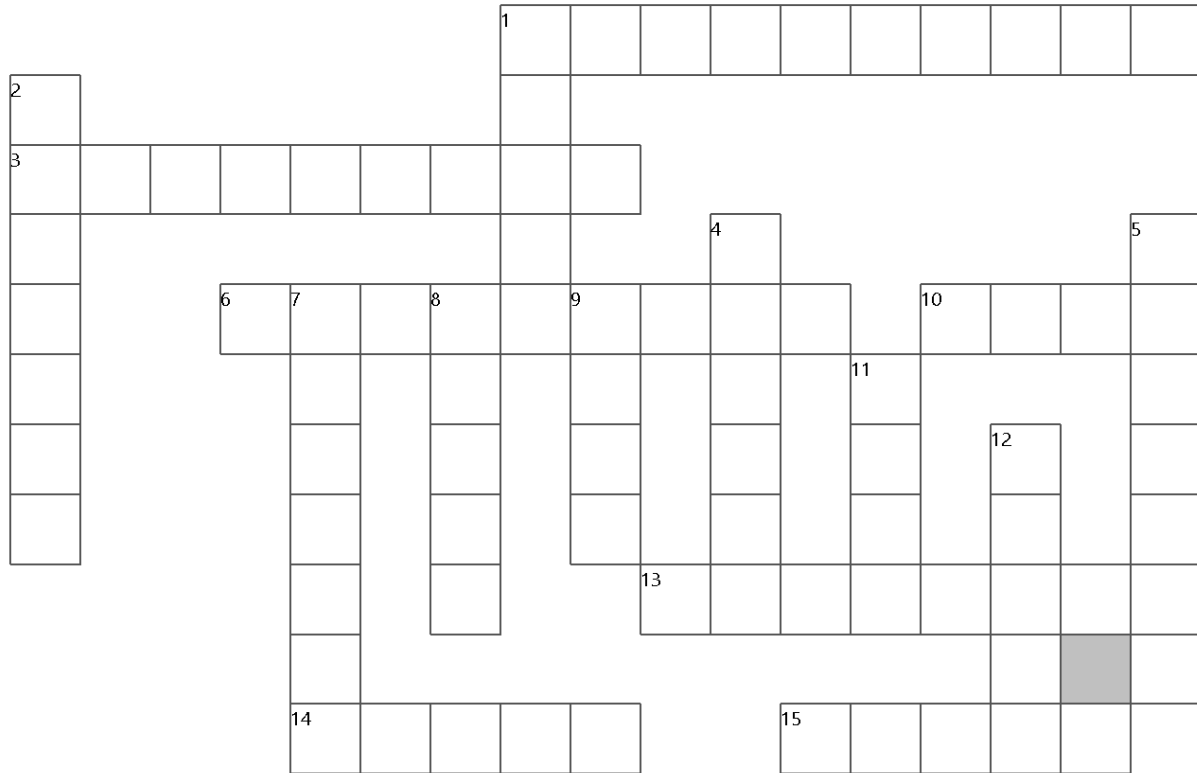


Human Body Crossword



ACROSS

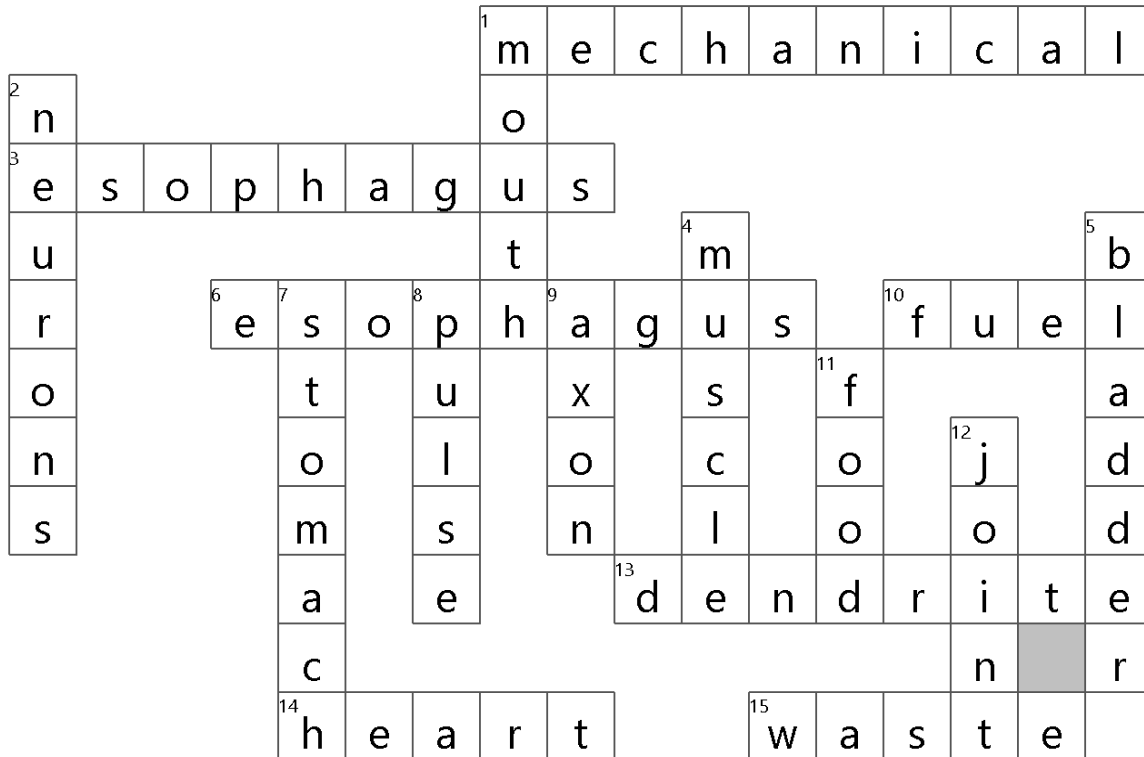
1. Chewing is an example of _____ digestion.
