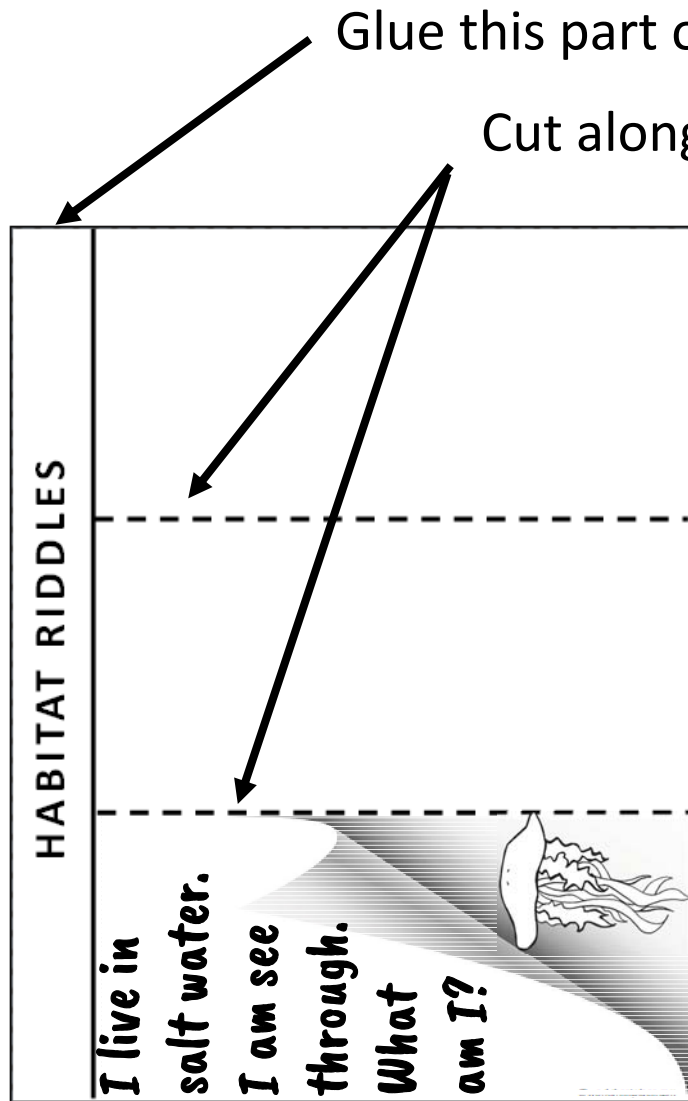


INTERACTIVE NOTEBOOK

SUGGESTED USE FOR INTERACTIVE NOTEBOOK TEMPLATE AND SAMPLE RIDDLES TO READ TO STUDENTS

The template for riddles can be used in a variety of ways in order to differentiate for all students. Students can print riddles on the outside with the picture answer inside, or they can use the clipart for the inside and describing words on the outside or the habitat on the inside and the animal on the out which wouldn't require any words. Prior to having students do the interactive notebook riddles, here are a few to read to stimulate thought.

1. I have 8 arms. I live in salt water. I have suction cups on my 8 arms.
Where might I live and what might I be? Ocean and an Octopus.
2. I have feathers and I quack. I find my food and shelter in water.
Where might I live and what might I be? A duck in the Wetland.
3. I am the largest animal on earth but I live in the water! I love eating fish and krill and like to migrate to warmer waters in the winter.
Where might I live and what might I be? Whale (Blue) and the Ocean.
4. I am a non living thing that happens in oceans. I happen twice a day.
What might I be? The tides.
5. I am a type of fish. I live sometimes in the ocean and sometimes in the rivers. I am a type of fish that people like to eat.
What might I be? A salmon fish.
6. I am a bit clear and some of my predators can't see me. I live in the ocean.
What might I be? A jellyfish.
