

# Penny Values



How many cents?  $1\text{c} = 1\text{¢}$

Box 1: Five 1-cent coins are scattered inside a square frame. A smaller square box is attached to the bottom right corner of the main box, containing a cent sign (¢).

Box 2: Six 1-cent coins are scattered inside a square frame. A smaller square box is attached to the bottom right corner of the main box, containing a cent sign (¢).

Box 3: Eight 1-cent coins are scattered inside a square frame. A smaller square box is attached to the bottom right corner of the main box, containing a cent sign (¢).

Box 4: Seven 1-cent coins are scattered inside a square frame. A smaller square box is attached to the bottom right corner of the main box, containing a cent sign (¢).

Box 5: Ten 1-cent coins are arranged in two rows of five. An equals sign (=) is placed to the right of the second row. To the right of the equals sign is a large empty square box containing a cent sign (¢).
