3. If there are 6 cupcakes in each box and there are 3 boxes, how many cupcakes are there in total?
4. Jackie's garden has 3 rows of pumpkins. Each row has 8 pumpkins. How many pumpkins does Jackie have in all?
5. Each person has 4 apples, if there are 7 people, how many apples are there in total?
6. There are 8 chocolates in a carton. How many chocolates are there in 3 cartons?
7. Mara swims 5 laps every day. How many laps will Mara swim in 6 days?
8. David can cycle 4 miles per hour. How far can David cycle in 8 hours?
9. Amy has 3 peaches but her friend Bella has 3 times what she has. How many peaches does Bella have?
10. There are 2 balls in a carton. How many balls are there in 7 cartons?
