4. If I do 122 minutes of homework every night. How many minutes of homework will I have done in 12 nights?
5. Mia swims 124 laps every day. How many laps will Mia swim in 12 days?
6. Jake can cycle 144 miles per hour. How far can Jake cycle in 2 hours?
7. I have 147 photos in my book. My friend has 16 times as many photos as I do in her book. How many photos does my friend have in her book?
8. Jackie's garden has 102 rows of pumpkins. Each row has 12 pumpkins. How many pumpkins does Jackie have in all?
9. If there are 134 train arrivals every day. How many train arrivals are there in 11 days?
10. There are 105 candies in a carton. How many candies are there in 6 cartons?
