

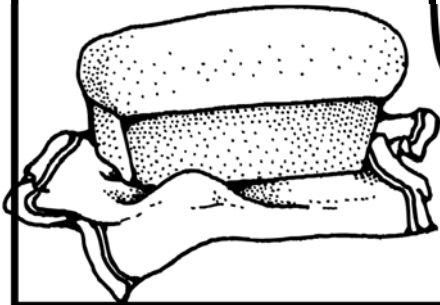
Puzzle Pieces for Interactive Notebooks. Use one side for the singular form, the other side for the rule and the inside for the plural form of the word. Glue vertical edges. First puzzle provides example. The puzzle pieces need to be cut out and they will serve as flaps once glued on the long vertical edges in the student notebook. Give students a list of words to use. **EXAMPLE:**

To use in interactive notebook:

Using the blank template, cut out both sides of the puzzle pieces.

Glue the right and left edges down so that the puzzle fits together. The puzzle pieces then act like a flap to the answer or the picture depending on how you've instructed students.
