I see my friend Ben.

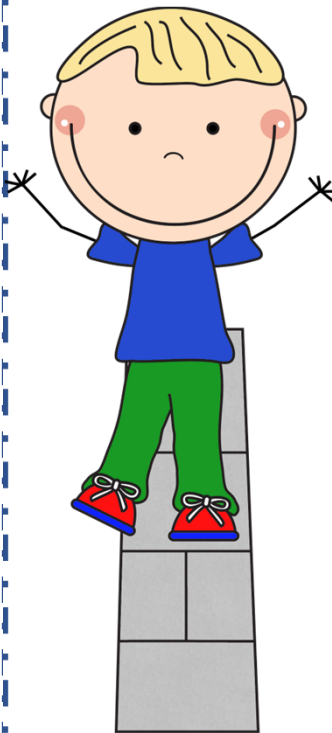
We play tag.
