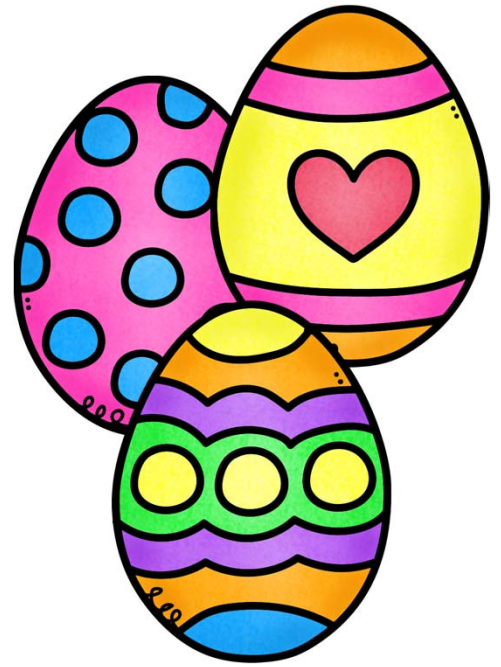


EaSter
