She takes the tooth. 

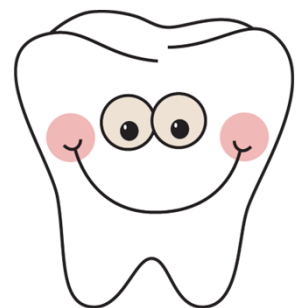
She leaves a surprise, like money
