I don't think a book about a cook

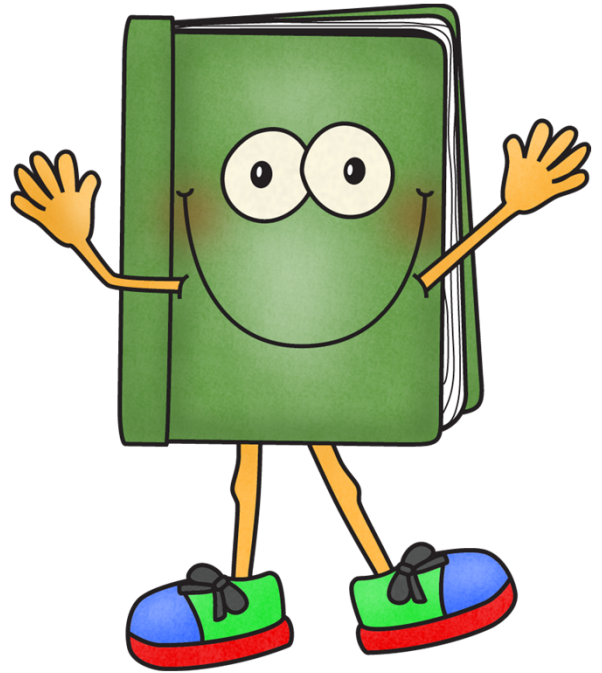
would hook me to read.
