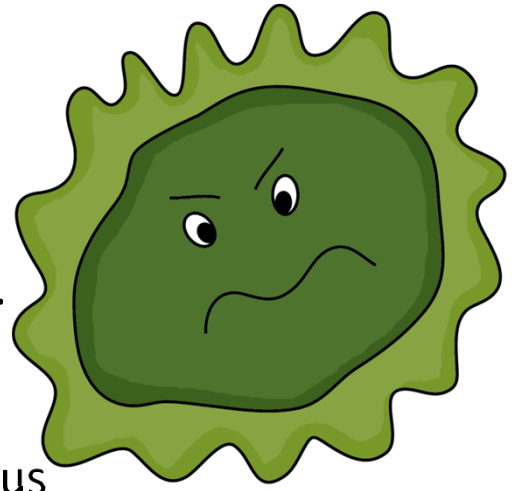


# Germs

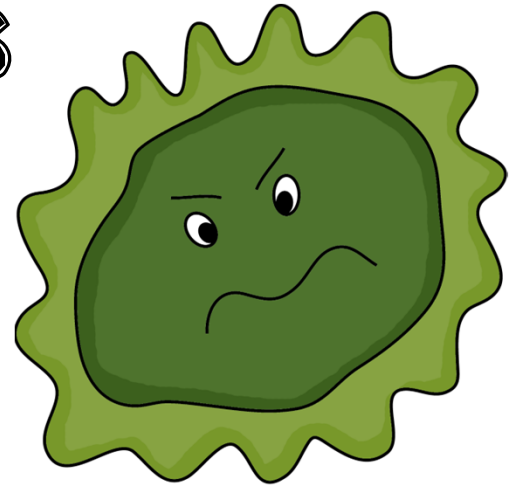


Germs are tiny and little and we can't see them. They can be found all around us.
