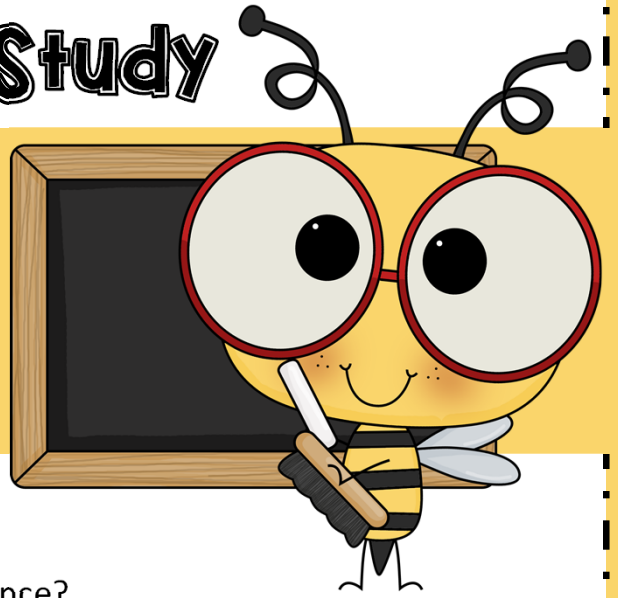


Sentence Study
