- ③ 35 oranges are in the basket. 23 are red and the rest are green. How many oranges are green?

- ④ 48 peaches were in the bin. Some of the peaches were removed from the bin. Now there are 19 peaches. How many peaches were removed from the bin?

- ⑤ Charlie has five apples. Brody has 45 apples. How many more apples does Brody have than Charlie?
