# Weather and Seasons

Weather and seasons are daily parts of nature that we feel and see every day. Let's learn about them!

Weather is what the air outside feels like. Sometimes it's sunny, and the sky is clear and bright. Other times,



it might be cloudy, and rain or snow might fall from the sky. We can feel the wind blowing gently or strongly. Seasons are different times of the year.

There are four seasons: spring, summer, fall (or autumn), and winter. Each season brings different weather and changes outside. In spring, flowers bloom, and trees grow new leaves. Summer is when it's usually warm, and we can play outside a lot. Fall brings colorful leaves falling from trees, and it gets a bit cooler. Winter is the coldest season, and we might see snow, ice, or frost. We can dress differently for each season to stay comfortable. It's fun to notice the changes in weather and seasons around us!
