

Different Jobs



People do many different jobs. Each job is important. Let's learn about some jobs.

A teacher helps children learn. Teachers read books, write on the board, and help kids with math. They make learning fun.

A doctor helps people feel better. Doctors check your heart and look in your ears. They give medicine to make you well.

A firefighter puts out fires. They drive big red trucks. Firefighters wear special suits to stay safe. They help people in danger.

A police officer keeps us safe. They make sure everyone follows the rules. Police officers help people who are lost or need help.

A farmer grows food. Farmers plant seeds in the ground. They take care of animals like cows and chickens. We get milk, eggs, and vegetables from farms.

A builder makes houses and buildings. Builders use tools like hammers and saws. They work hard to make strong homes.

A chef cooks food. Chefs make tasty meals in restaurants. They use pots, pans, and ovens to cook. Chefs make sure the food tastes good.

A driver takes people places. Bus drivers and taxi drivers help us get where we need to go. They drive safely on the roads.

A shopkeeper sells things. Shopkeepers work in stores. They help us buy toys, clothes, and food. They are friendly and help us find what we need.
